

Ina Drive closed Thursday 14 March 2024 – Saturday 16 March 2024

Health Infrastructure has appointed Richard Crookes Constructions to deliver the main works for the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment. We recognise that building new infrastructure can impact nearby residents, patients, staff and road users. All construction activities will be carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

Ina Drive closed: 14-16 March 2024

As part of the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment work is required to provide a new permanent sewer connection to the property, No 2 Ina Drive, Tresillian Family Care Centre. Ina Drive will be closed out at high intersection with Carleton Street as show on the map below. Alternate access for properties 2, 3, 5 and 7 Ina Drive will be available via Len Whiteley Drive, as indicated by the red arrows in the map below.

There will be no disruption to Ina Drive between Liverpool and Carleton Streets.



Mitigation and control measures

All major construction projects, like the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment, must comply with strict environmental and planning controls. The following measures will be in place:

- Sediment control and dust suppression
- Air monitoring on perimeter fence and at the work face
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Traffic management

How will the work affect you?

The works times will be between 7.00am and 5.00pm on Thursday 14 March and Friday 15 March 2024 and take place between 8.00am to 1.00pm on Saturday 16 March 2024. Council approval has been provided to Richard Crookes Constructions to undertake this work to minimise disruption to the Tresillian Family Care Centre operations.

If unforeseen circumstances occur and the activity is rescheduled, the community will be notified.
